Acceptable and Unacceptable Materials:

printer friendly Recycling Center Sheet

Not Accepted (*To avoid any confusion, please review the list of items WE DO NOT ACCEPT before loading your vehicle*):

- Plastic: plastic bags, pool liners, furniture, toys, buckets etc.
- Wood: furniture, TV stands, speakers, organs/pianos, anything in a wooden case or cabinet (*except for console or rear projection TVs*)
- Specialty glass: windows, sheet glass, automotive glass, mirrors, ceramics/toilets, candles
- Incandescent light bulbs
- Ink/toner cartridges
- Mattresses, carpet, upholstered furniture
- Medicines and medical equipment

- Vacuum cleaners, rug scrubbers
- Small appliances that are mostly plastic, glass, or ceramic (coffee makers, lamps); dishwashers with plastic drum
- Single-use alkaline or rechargeable batteries, tool batteries, loose lithium ion laptop batteries

When in doubt, ask staff.

Acceptable Materials

- All electronics listed below (TVs, computers and peripherals, small appliances) NO CHARGE for most items
 - EXCEPT: Hazardous waste handling fee of \$25 will be charged for disassembled/smashed CRT TVs and monitors
- Glass bottles and jars: clear, green brown (must be separated by color). No blue bottle glass NO CHARGE
- NEW: Plastics 1-7 and vinyl siding and fencing: click for details
- Paper as listed (please separate): NO CHARGE
 - Cardboard (corrugated, chip board, cereal boxes)
 - Sorted Office Paper (white; staples and paperclips OK)
 - Mixed paper (file folders, junk mail, magazines, phone books)
 - Newspaper (black and white, color inserts)
 - Corrugated Plastic signs (coroplast)
- EPS (expanded polystyrene) #6 Foam (commonly referred to as Styrofoam): NO CHARGE,

Video: How to Recycle Foam at the Center

- Separate by type:
 - White Block Packaging Foam, Coolers
 - Colored and white food service trays (CLEAN OFF ALL FOOD RESIDUE): cups, plates, grocery store trays, egg cartons, fast food containers
- NOT RECYCLABLE: Packing peanuts, Rigid foam sheet insulation typically used in construction; "Spongey" block packaging
- Car/Light Truck Tires: \$4.00 Off Rim/\$5.00 On Rim*
- Tractor Trailer: \$15.00 Off Rim/ \$18.00 On Rim*
- Agricultural/farm tractor: \$80.00*
- Highway/construction/heavy equipment: \$80.00*
- Refrigerant-containing Appliances (frig, freezers, A/C, dehumidifiers, etc.): \$20.00/unit
- Scrap Metal (non-refrigerant appliances, propane tanks, gas grills, lawn mowers, car parts, tools, cans, misc.): NO CHARGE
- Lead Acid Batteries; Uninterruptible Power Supplies (UPS): NO CHARGE

- Used Motor Oil: NO CHARGE
- Bulbs and Fixtures:
 - Ballasts (PCB or non-PCB) \$5.00 each
 - CFL (compact fluorescent)/small LED \$1.00 each (change in price in June 2022)
 - Specialty bulbs: fluorescent tubes 4ft or smaller, u-bend, halogen, HID, high pressure sodium, LED, etc. \$1.00 each
 - Fluorescent tubes 8ft or longer \$2.00 each
- Household hazardous waste (paint, chemicals)* 1st and 3rd Wednesday of each month when Noble Environmental is on site. Visit the link for details on acceptable material and costs.

*Members receive discount on tire disposal

Electronics, that by law must be recycled: *(anything directly connected to a computer system):* Video: How to Recycle Electronics

- TVs—all types (CRT tube; flat screen, rear projection, consoles (whole, intact, complete unit)
- Hazardous waste handling fee of \$25 will be charged for disassembled/smashed CRT TVs and monitors
- Computer monitors—CRT tube, flat screen, and LED/LCD
- CPUs/Towers
- Laptops, iPads, tablets
- Peripherals (mice, keyboards, speakers)
- Printers and All-in-One Printers

Electronics Not required by law to be recycled but CAN be:

- Answering Machines
- Camcorders
- Cameras
- Cell phones
- Christmas light strings
- Docking Stations
- Electric typewriters
- Electrical Cords
- Fax/copy machines/duplicators
- Gaming consoles/controllers
- Microwaves
- Pagers
- Radios

- Remote Controls
- Stereos/tape/CD players
- Telephone systems
- Testing equipment
- VCR/DVD players
- Video games/cartridges

A Visit to the Center – What to Expect

- Where fees apply, we accept cash, checks (payable to Westmoreland Cleanways) or debit/credit cards.
- Be prepared to take plastic bags, bins and baskets back home unless they are to be recycled (cardboard boxes)
- Material should be pre-sorted as follows for ease in unloading vehicles. Sequence of drop-off in roughly the following order:
 - Scrap Metal (Freon appliances*, car parts, tools, etc.) (*see price list)
 - · Plastics and vinyl siding and fencing, click for details
 - Glass bottles and jars (separate by color)
 - Metal lids must be removed; can be recycled with scrap metal
 - No corks
 - Electronics (2 categories):
 - Screens (TVs, monitors, CRTs, flat panel displays; wood cabinet consoles; rear projection)
 - All other electronic devices and small appliances
 - Tires* (*see price list)
 - Lead Acid Batteries
 - Light fixtures* (tubes, bulbs, ballast) (*see price list)
 - Paper (separate by category):
 - Cardboard (cardboard, cereal boxes, brown paper bags, etc.)
 - Newsprint (B&W, color inserts)
 - Mixed Paper (magazines/catalogs, junk mail, file folders, colored/heavily printed office paper)
 - White Office Paper (white paper only; shredded paper)
 - Books: both hard and softback
 - Corrugated plastic signs such as political campaigns, community events, and tradespeople advertisements (remove stands and grommets)
 - Misc. items as directed by staff
